



Inspire School of Dance Rules Revised Jan 2008

These rules ensure the safety and enjoyment of each pupil whilst under the supervision of Inspire school of Dance. In the first instance of any of these rules not being adhered to the pupil would be asked to sit out of the class. In the second instance their parent/guardian would be contacted and the pupil would be asked not to return to the dance school until there behaviour was of a satisfactory manner.

- Pupils must stop, look and listen when asked to do so by a dance school adult.
- All pupils, staff and parents/guardians must treat each other with the respect that they would wish to be treated. This also applies to personal belongings and buildings.
- Appropriate clothing must be worn to the classes ideally the dance school uniform. Pupils will not be allowed to dance barefoot or in socks.
- No hot drinks will be allowed in the teaching room. Pupils should bring a drink to the classes in plastic bottles. No cans or glass bottles are allowed. Pupils will not be allowed into the kitchen area.
- Chewing gum is not permitted in the teaching room.
- Long hair should be tied back and loose jewellery/hooped earrings must be removed.
- Fees must be paid at the start of each class. If paying by cheque a 50p sur-charge will be added for bank charges. A £25 administration and banking fee will be added to any cheque returned by the bank.
- Mobile phones must be turned off or switched to silent if brought in to the teaching room.
- Leave valuables at home as Inspire School of Dance do not undertake any responsibility for any money or articles of value lost on the premises.
- The School reserve the right to amend or alter these rules at any time.
